SUBJECT: CCW Qualification Course

In compliance with Assembly Bill 2103, The Sutter County Sheriff's Office is required to provide its course of fire to be completed by all CCW applicants. The course of fire shall be as follows:

- 15 Yards 10 Rounds.
- 7 Yards 5 Rounds.
- 3 Yards 5 Rounds strong hand, unsupported.
- 3 Yards 5 Rounds strong hand, supported.

All rounds must be on the target with 80% inside the silhouette to qualify as passing.

- A standard B27 target will be used for the qualification.
- A total of 25 rounds per firearms is required.
- Each firearm to be carried under the permit must be used to pass the course of fire.

The requirement that persons qualify on each firearm to be permitted is in compliance with 26165(a) (3) of the California Penal Code.

The standards regarding course of fire is in compliance with 26165(b) of the California Penal Code.

To remain on our approved CCW firearms instructor list, you shall adjust your course of fire to match our requirements. Any questions can be directed to our CCW Coordinator, Lieutenant Matt Maples at (530) 822-7307.
