Voting Instructions – paper ballot



Mark your ballot

Use a pen with blue or black ink to fill in the oval to the left of the candidate's name you wish to vote for. Do not use red ink, pencil, or Sharpie.



To mark your choice, fill in the oval completely.

Voting for more than allowed for a contest will be an over vote and no votes for that contest will be counted. The rest of the ballot will count.

Do not sign your name, write your initials, or write any other words/marks on your voted ballot.



To vote for a **qualified** write-in candidate, write their name in the blank space at the end of the list of candidates. A list of qualified write-in candidates is available by phone, at polling places, or online at www.suttercounty.org/elections.

Visiting any Polling Place on Election Day before 8:00 pm.

Vote in person

To vote a ballot at the polls, visit your polling place noted on your Vote by Mail envelope located under your name and request a ballot from the pollworker.

United States Senate Race

The office of United States Senate must appear two times on the November 8, 2022 General Election ballot. Each is for a separate term of office.

Therefore:

There are two U.S. Senate contests on the November 8, 2022, General Election ballot.

The first contest is the regular election for the full 6 year term ending January 3, 2029.

The second contest is a special vacancy election (the current officeholder is temporarily filling a vacancy) for the remainder of the current term ending January 3, 2023.

You may vote for both contests.



Expenditure Limitations

Voters passed Proposition 34 in November 2000 which says we must tell voters the names of candidates who agree to campaign spending limits. This law only applies to candidates for State Legislative Offices.

AGE: 36

Occupation: U.S. Army Reservist

Education and Qualifications: I am a combat veteran, a political moderate and a fifth-generation Californian. I am pro-choice, pro-gun, and pro-America.

We need to make big changes in Washington. We need fewer career politicians. We need patriotic elected officials who will put principles over party. We need politicians who will stand up and say "no" to the political extremes of the far-left and the far-right. We need politicians who will truly put America first.

My legislative priorities as your Representative would cut across party lines: protecting the fundamentals of our democracy by respecting the results of free and fair elections; reducing fire risk by thinning our forests, strengthening the timber industry, and using prescribed fire; hiring more firefighters and paying them better; building more dams to reduce the impacts of climate change; codifying Roe v. Wade into law to protect reproductive privacy rights; ensuring security abroad with a strong military and security at home with strong police forces.

I am not a typical politician. At 19, I joined the Army and served two years in Iraq as an infantryman with the 10th Mountain Division. I am now a First Sergeant in the U.S. Army Reserves. I used my G.I. bill to attend U.C. Berkeley. I then served eight years as a U.S. diplomat, working on agriculture in Honduras, immigration in Mexico, and as a peacekeeper in Egypt.

I will put the needs of CD-1 first and my personal interests last.

Necesitamos hacer grandes cambios en Washington. Necesitamos menos políticos profesionales. Necesitamos funcionarios patriotas electos que pongan los principios por encima de los partidos. Question: Sutter County Essential Services Measure, Shall an ordinance generating locally controlled revenue for Sutter County's general purposes, such as maintaining fire and emergency response times, sheriff's patrols, wildfire response, veterans services; providing firefighting equipment/training; repairing roads; addressing homelessness; preventing County fire station closure; ensuring fiscal stability, by levying a 1 ¢ sales tax for 9 years, raising approximately \$19,600,000 annually that cannot be taken by Sacramento, requiring audits, citizens' oversight, public review/disclosure of spending, be adopted?

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF SUTTER AMENDING THE SUTTER COUNTY ORDINANCE CODE BY ADDING CHAPTER 105 PERTAINING TO TRANSACTIONS (SALES) AND USE TAX

THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF SUTTER ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Sutter County Ordinance Code is amended by adding Chapter 105 to read, in its entirety, as follows:

Chapter 105

105-010 TITLE

This Chapter shall be known as the County of Sutter Retail Transactions (Sales) and Use Tax Ordinance. The County of Sutter shall hereinafter be called "County." This Chapter shall be applicable in the incorporated and unincorporated territory of the County.

105-020 OPERATIVE DATE

"Operative Date" means the first day of the first calendar quarter commencing more than 110 days after the effective date of the ordinance amending this Chapter.

105-030 PURPOSE

This Chapter is adopted to achieve the following, among other purposes, and the provisions hereof shall be interpreted in order to accomplish those purposes:



- a) To adopt a retail transactions and use tax in accordance with the provisions of Part 1.6 (commencing with Section 7251) of Division 2 of the Revenue and Taxation Code and Section 7285 of Part 1.7 of Division 2 which authorizes the County to adopt this tax ordinance, which shall be operative if a majority of the electors voting on the measure vote to approve the imposition of the tax at an election called for that purpose.
- b) To adopt a retail transactions and use tax that incorporates provisions identical to those of the Sales and Use Tax Law of the State of California insofar as those provisions are not inconsistent with the requirements and limitations contained in Part 1.6 of Division 2 of the Revenue and Tax Code.
- c) To adopt a retail transactions and use tax that imposes a tax and provides a measure therefore that can be administered and collected by the California Department of Tax and Fee Administration in a manner that adapts itself as fully as practicable to, and requires the least possible deviation from, the existing statutory and administrative procedures followed by the California Department of Tax and Fee Administration in administering and collecting the California State Sales and Use Taxes.
- d) To adopt a retail transactions and use tax ordinance that can be administered in a manner that will be, to the greatest degree possible, consistent with the provisions of Part 1.6 of Division 2 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, minimize the cost of collecting the transactions and use taxes, and at the same time, minimize the burden of record keeping upon persons subject to taxation under the provisions of this Chapter.

105-040 CONTRACT WITH STATE

Prior to the Operative Date, the County shall contract with the California Department of Tax and Fee Administration to perform all functions incident to the administration and operation of this Chapter; provided, that if the County shall not have contracted with the California Department of Tax and Fee Administration prior to the Operative Date, it shall nevertheless so contract and in such a case the Operative Date shall be the first day of the first calendar quarter following execution of such a contract.

105-050 TRANSACTION TAX RATE

For the privilege of selling tangible personal property at retail, a tax is hereby imposed upon all retailers in the incorporated and unincorporated territory of the County at the rate one percent (1.0%) of the gross receipts of any retailer from the sale of all tangible personal property sold at retail in said territory on and after the Operative Date.

105-060 PLACE OF SALE

For the purposes of this Chapter, all retail sales are consummated at the place of business of the retailer unless the tangible personal property sold is delivered by the retailer or his agent to an out-of-state destination or to a common carrier for delivery to an out-of-state destination. The gross receipts from such sales shall include delivery charges, when such charges are subject to the state sales and use tax, regardless of the place to which delivery is made. In the event a retailer has no permanent place of business in the State or has more than one place of business, the place or places at which the retail sales are consummated shall be determined under rules and regulations to be prescribed and adopted by the California Department of Tax and Fee Administration.

105-070 USE TAX RATE

An excise tax is hereby imposed on the storage, use or other consumption in the County of tangible personal property purchased from any retailer on and after the Operative Date for storage, use or other consumption in said territory at the rate of one percent (1.0%) of the sales price of the property. The sales price shall include delivery charges, when such charges are subject to the state sales and use tax, regardless of the place to which delivery is made.



105-080 ADOPTION OF PROVISIONS OF STATE LAW

Except as otherwise provided in this Chapter and except insofar as they are inconsistent with the provisions of Part 1.6 of Division 2 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, all of the provisions of Part 1 (commencing with Section 6001) of Division 2 of the Revenue and Taxation Code are hereby adopted and made a part of this Chapter as though fully set forth herein.

105-090 LIMITATIONS ON ADOPTION OF STATE LAW AND COLLECTION OF USE TAX

In adopting the provisions of Part 1.6 of Division 2 of the Revenue and Taxation Code:

- A. Wherever the State of California is named or referred to as the taxing agency, the name of this County shall be substituted therefor. However, the substitution shall not be made when:
- 1) The word "State" is used as a part of the title of the State Controller, State Treasurer, State Board of Control, State Board of Equalization, State Treasury, or the Constitution of the State of California;
 - 2) The result of that substitution would require action to be taken by or against the County or any agency, officer, or employee thereof rather than by or against the California Department of Tax and Fee Administration in performing the functions incident to the administration or operation of this Chapter;
 - 3) In those sections, including, but not necessarily limited to, sections referring to the exterior boundaries of the State of California, where the result of the substitution would be to:
 - a. Provide an exemption from this tax with respect to certain sales, storage, use or other consumption of tangible personal property which would not otherwise be exempt from this tax while such sales, storage, use or other consumptions remain subject to tax by the State under provisions of Part 1 of Division 2 of the Revenue and Taxation code; or
 - b. Impose this tax with respect to certain sales, storage, use or other consumption of tangible personal property which would not be subject to tax by the state under the said provision of that code.
 - 4) The word "State" appears in Sections 6701, 6702 (except in the last sentence thereof), 6711, 6715, 6737, 6797 or 6828 of the Revenue and Taxation Code.
- B. The word "County" shall be substituted for the word "State" in the phrase "retailer engaged in business in this State" in Section 6203 and in the definition of that phrase in Section 6203.
- C. A "retailer engaged in business in this County" shall also include any retailer that, in the preceding calendar year or the current calendar year, has total combined sales that exceeds five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000). For purposes of this section, a person is related to another person if both persons are related to each other pursuant to Section 267(b) of Title 26 of the United States Code and the regulations thereunder.

105-100 PERMIT NOT REQUIRED

If a seller's permit has been issued to a retailer under Section 6067 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, an additional transactor's permit shall not be required by this Chapter.

105-110 EXEMPTIONS AND EXCLUSIONS

- A. There shall be excluded from the measure of the transactions tax and the use tax the amount of



any sales tax or use tax imposed by the State of California or by any city, city and county, or county pursuant to the Bradley-Burns Uniform Local Sales and Use Tax Law, or the amount of any state-administered transactions or use tax.

B. There are exempted from the computation of the amount of transactions tax the gross receipts from:

- 1) Sales of tangible personal property, other than fuel or petroleum products, to operators of aircraft to be used or consumed principally outside the County in which the sale is made and directly and exclusively in the use of such aircraft as common carriers of persons or property under the authority of the laws of this State, the United States, or any foreign government.
- 2) Sales of property to be used outside the County which is shipped to a point outside the County, pursuant to the contract of sale, by delivery to such point by the retailer or his agent, or by delivery by the retailer to a carrier for shipment to a consignee at such point. For purposes of this paragraph, delivery to a point outside the County shall be satisfied:
 - a. With respect to vehicles (other than commercial vehicles) subject to registration pursuant to Chapter 1 (commencing with Section 4000) of Division 3 of the Vehicle Code, aircraft licensed in compliance with Section 21411 of the Public Utilities Code, and undocumented vessels registered under Division 3.5 (commencing with Section 9840) of the Vehicle Code by registration to an out-of-County address and by declaration under penalty of perjury, signed by the buyer, stating that such address is, in fact, his or her principal place of residence; and
 - b. With respect to commercial vehicles, by registration to a place of business out-of-County and declaration under penalty of perjury, signed by the buyer, that the vehicle will be operated from that address.
- 3) The sale of tangible personal property if the seller is obligated to furnish the property for a fixed price pursuant to a contract entered into prior to the Operative Date of this ordinance.
- 4) A lease of tangible personal property which is a continuing sale of such property, for any period of time for which the lessor is obligated to lease the property for an amount fixed by the lease prior to the Operative Date of this ordinance.
- 5) For purposes of subparagraphs (3) and (4) of this section, the sale or lease of tangible personal property shall be deemed not to be obligated pursuant to a contract or lease for any period of time for which any party to the contract or lease has the unconditional right to terminate the contract or lease upon notice, whether or not such right is exercised.

C. There are exempted from the use tax imposed by this Chapter, the storage, use or other consumption in this County of tangible personal property:

- 1) The gross receipts from the sale of which have been subject to a transactions tax under any state-administered transactions and use tax ordinance.
- 2) Other than fuel or petroleum products purchased by operators of aircraft and used or consumed by such operators directly and exclusively in the use of such aircraft as common carriers of persons or property for hire or compensation under a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued pursuant to the laws of this State, the United States, or any foreign government. This exemption is in addition to the exemptions provided in Sections 6366 and 6366.1 of the Revenue and Taxation Code of the State of California.
- 3) If the purchaser is obligated to purchase the property for a fixed price pursuant to a contract entered into prior to the Operative Date of this ordinance.
- 4) If the possession of, or the exercise of any right or power over, the tangible personal property arises under a lease which is a continuing purchase of such property for any period of time for which the lessee is obligated to lease the property for an amount fixed by a lease prior to the Operative Date of this ordinance.



- 5) For purposes of subparagraphs (3) and (4) of this section, storage, use, or other consumption, or possession of, or exercise of, any right or power over tangible personal property shall be deemed not to be obligated pursuant to a contract or lease for any period of time for which any party to the contract or lease has the unconditional right to terminate the contract or lease upon notice, whether or not such right is exercised.
 - 6) Except as provided in subparagraph (7) of this section, a retailer engaged in business in the County shall not be required to collect use tax from the purchaser of tangible personal property, unless the retailer ships or delivers the property into the County or participates within the County in making the sale of the property, including, but not limited to, soliciting or receiving the order, either directly or indirectly, at a place of business of the retailer in the County or through any representative, agent, canvasser, solicitor, subsidiary, or person in the County under the authority of the retailer.
 - 7) "A retailer engaged in business in the County" shall also include any retailer of any of the following vehicles subject to registration pursuant to Chapter 1 (commencing with Section 4000) of Division 3 of the Vehicle Code, aircraft licensed in compliance with Section 21411 of the Public Utilities Code, or undocumented vessels registered under Division 3.5 (commencing with Section 9840) of the Vehicle Code. That retailer shall be required to collect use tax from any purchaser who registers or licenses the vehicle, vessel, or aircraft at an address in the County.
- D. Any person subject to use tax under this Chapter may credit against that tax any transactions tax or reimbursement for transactions tax paid to a city or county imposing, or retailer liable for, a transactions tax pursuant to Part 1.6 of Division 2 of the Revenue and Taxation Code with respect to the sale to the person of the property, the storage, use, or other consumption, which is subject to the use tax.

105-120 AMENDMENTS

All amendments to Part 1 of Division 2 of the Revenue and Taxation Code that are made subsequent to the effective date of this Chapter relating to sales and use taxes and which are not inconsistent with Part 1.6 and Part 1.7 of Division 2 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, and all amendments to Part 1.6 and Part 1.7 of Division 2 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, shall automatically become a part of this Chapter, provided however, that no such amendment shall operate so as to affect the rate of tax imposed by this Chapter or the duration thereof.

105-130 INDEPENDENT COMMUNITY OVERSIGHT

A five-member Independent Community Advisory Committee will be created and shall meet annually to review the expenditure of revenues generated by the tax imposed by this Chapter and to make recommendations to the board of supervisors regarding those expenditures. Members of the committee will be appointed to terms of not more than 4 years by the board of supervisors. The Independent Community Advisory Committee shall meet publicly on at least a quarterly basis to review all revenues and expenditures of the transactions and use tax imposed by this chapter, review annual audit reports related to the tax, and make at least one written annual report to the board of supervisors at a public meeting summarizing the Independent Community Advisory Committee's findings and including any appropriate recommendations. The minutes of the meetings of Independent Community Advisory Committee shall be provided to the board of supervisors and placed on the next available regular board of supervisors meeting agenda for informational purposes.

105-140 AUDIT

The proceeds of the tax imposed by this Chapter, as well as the expenditure thereof, shall be audited annually by an independent accounting firm. The board of supervisors shall discuss the results of such audit at a meeting of the board of supervisors that is open to the public. The report of such audit shall be posted on the County's website.

105-150 SUNSET

The tax imposed by this Chapter shall be imposed for nine years from the Operative Date of the tax as defined in section 105-020 of this Chapter and, thereafter, shall no longer be imposed.



SECTION 2: ENJOINING COLLECTION PROHIBITED

No injunction or writ of mandate or other legal or equitable process shall issue in any suit, action or proceeding in any court against the State or the County, or against any officer of the State or the County, to prevent or enjoin the collection under this Chapter, or Part 1.6 of Division 2 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, of any tax or any amount of tax required to be collected.

SECTION 3: RELATIONSHIP TO EXISTING TAX

The transactions and use tax imposed by this ordinance is separate from, and in addition to, any other taxes currently imposed by the County. Nothing in this ordinance shall be interpreted to affect the rate or administration of any tax other than the transactions and use imposed by this ordinance.

SECTION 4: COMPLIANCE WITH CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT

Pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines sections 15060(c)(2) and 15378(b)(2) and (4), adoption of this ordinance will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment and is not a "project" subject to the requirements of CEQA.

SECTION 5: SEVERABILITY If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, portion, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof. The Board of Supervisors hereby declares that it would have passed this Chapter and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, portion, or phrase hereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared illegal, invalid or unconstitutional.



COUNTY COUNSEL'S IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS OF MEASURE A

Measure A, the "Sutter County Essential Services Measure," seeks voter approval to add the County of Sutter Retail Transactions (Sales) and Use Tax Ordinance to the Sutter County Ordinance Code.

This ordinance would add a one percent (1%) sales and use tax on transactions in Sutter County. Sales tax applies to all retail sales of goods and merchandise except those sales specifically exempted by law. Use tax generally applies to the storage, use, or other consumption of goods purchased from retailers in transactions not subject to the sales tax.

This tax would be collected in addition to the statewide base sales and use tax rate, which is currently 7.25%. If this ordinance is approved, subject to changes in the base rate, the sales and use tax rate in Sutter County would be 8.25%. This tax would apply to all transactions in Sutter County, including in incorporated cities.

Sutter County's ability to spend the revenue raised by this general purpose tax would be unrestricted. Tax revenue would be deposited into Sutter County's general fund to be used for any governmental purpose. Permissible uses could include, but would not be limited to, essential services such as addressing homelessness, maintaining fire, emergency medical, and Sheriff response times, preventing the closure of a County Fire Station, upgrading firefighting equipment to meet safety standards, repairing roads, and supporting local businesses.

The ordinance creates an Independent Community Advisory Committee that would make recommendations to the Sutter County Board of Supervisors about how to spend the tax revenue. It would also require an annual independent audit of how the revenues are used.

If this measure is approved by a majority of voters, the Sutter County Board of Supervisors may vote to adopt the ordinance. The tax would be imposed following that vote, but no earlier than July 1, 2023. The tax would remain in effect for a period of nine (9) years.

This Measure was placed on the ballot by the Sutter County Board of Supervisors by a unanimous public vote on August 9, 2022.

A "yes" vote is in favor of approving the ordinance establishing the tax. A "no" vote is against approving the ordinance establishing the tax.

ARGUMENT IN FAVOR OF MEASURE A

The people of Sutter County have the right to decide the level of local government services we want. Adequate funding of our county government is important to quality of life. Sutter County, however, is at a crossroads. Despite lean staffing and salaries lower than neighboring jurisdictions, soon local revenues, limited by factors outside county control, will not meet the cost of current service levels. The expected gap grows to \$12 million annually by 2028.

Our community prioritizes public safety over all other County functions. The bulk of existing local tax dollars goes to public safety services such as law enforcement, jail operations, criminal prosecution, adult and juvenile probation, fire and emergency services. A much smaller portion goes to other general fund activities, many required by the state. In the last decade, general fund allocations to public safety departments have increased 38.6 percent, while budget cuts in general fund departments have kept growth to just 2.3 percent.

Sutter County has fewer employees per capita than all but one of California's 31 counties with a population below 200,000. Salaries are below market to the extent it is difficult to recruit and keep employees, particularly those in public safety positions. This will only get more difficult, and services will suffer.

Measure A will be able to fund local services like:

- More deputies, correctional officers, and 911 dispatchers
- Law enforcement positions to enforce camping laws
- More firefighters for primary response and to provide countywide mutual aid
- School resource officers to keep our children safe
- Much needed road and drainage repairs

Measure A funds stay local. An independent oversight committee will ensure every penny is accounted for and spent on crucial services for every Sutter County citizen in cities and the unincorporated area.

Vote Yes on Measure A. It will maintain and improve crucial local government services.

CITY ATTORNEY'S IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS OF MEASURE Z

Measure Z asks Yuba City voters whether the positions of City Clerk and City Treasurer of Yuba City should be appointed positions or elected positions. If Measure Z passes, the City Clerk and City Treasurer would be appointed by the City Council and no longer elected by Yuba City voters. The City Council would appoint the next City Clerk and City Treasurer when there are vacancies in the offices or when the terms of the current incumbents expire in December 2024, whichever is earlier. In lieu of making the appointments the City Council may also, by resolution, delegate that authority to the City Manager. The majority of California cities have appointed City Clerks and City Treasurers.

Currently in Yuba City, the elected City Clerk and City Treasurer serve four-year terms. California law requires that general law cities like Yuba City have either an elected or appointed City Clerk and City Treasurer. However, a transition from an elected City Clerk and City Treasurer to an appointed City Clerk and City Treasurer must be approved by the City's voters.

If Measure Z passes and the positions become appointed, the City Council may decide the minimum education and training requirements for the positions and appoint the City Clerk and City Treasurer. The measure requires a majority vote to pass.

A "yes" vote on Measure Z will convert the offices of City Clerk and City Treasurer of Yuba City into appointed positions, with the first appointments occurring following either an office vacancy or term expiration, whichever is sooner.

A "no" vote on Measure Z will leave the City Clerk and City Treasurer as elected offices. If Measure Z fails, the City Clerk and City Treasurer positions will remain elected.
