REQUIREMENTS: Representatives of program participants and the general public, including low-income and minority persons at least in proportion to the number of minority older persons in the area. Have available time to contribute to activities of the Advisory Council to maintain full representation from the County at regular meetings.

DUTIES: Advise the area agency on all matters relating to development and administration of the area plan and operations conducted there under. At least one-half of the membership of such council shall be made up of actual consumers of services under the area plan.

AUTHORITY: Federal regulations

COMPENSATION: Flat rate/mileage reimbursement

REQUIREMENTS: Membership will consist of one Supervisor (or designee) and one citizen from each County except Sacramento County where there will be one Supervisor and four citizens from that County. Alternate representatives' application shall be screened, and recommendation made by the County Commission or Council on Aging.

DUTIES: The Governing board shall establish all policy; establish procedural rules for expenditure and obligation and conditions on the use of funds; enter into and administer contracts and sub-grants for the purpose of carrying out the intent and functions of the OAA, the Older Californians Act (OCA) and all other pertinent laws, regulations and rules.

AUTHORITY: Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement between the counties of Nevada, Placer, Sacramento, Sierra, Sutter, Yolo and Yuba for the purpose of sponsoring the Area 4 Agency on Aging to implement the Older Americans Act as amended

COMPENSATION: None.

FORM 700: Required be filed within 30-days of assuming office and then annually. Must be filed within 30-days of leaving office.

REQUIREMENTS: Minimum of five years professional experience in this state as one of the following: certified public accountant or public accountant, licensed real estate broker, attorney, property appraiser accredited by a nationally recognized professional organization, or is a person who the nominating member of the Board of Supervisors has reason to believe is possessed of competent knowledge of property appraisal and taxation.

DUTIES:

- 1) Increase or lower, upon application, individual assessments in order to equalize assessments on the local tax assessment roll
- 2) Review, equalize and adjust penal and escaped assessments on that roll except escaped assessments made pursuant to Revenue and Taxation Code section 531.1
- 3) Pursuant to Revenue and Taxation Code section 1613, give certain directions to the assessor, under certain circumstances, regarding the assessment of property which has escaped assessment and making other corrections to the assessment roll

Form 700: Required to be filed within 30-days of assuming office and then annually. Must be filed within 30-days of leaving office.

REQUIREMENTS: A Commission of nine persons representing specific interests as defined in Prop10 of 1998.

DUTIES: Establish a strategic plan for the expenditure of funds made available to Sutter County as a result of Prop 10. Conduct at least one public hearing on the strategic plan, allocate funds according to the strategic plan, conduct an audit of the Children and Families First Trust Fund each year and hold at least one public hearing on the results of the audit. Maintain contact with the State of California Children and Families First Commission. Establish a technical advisory committee to provide advice to the Commission on developing the strategic plan.

AUTHORITY: Proposition 10 of 1998 California Health and Safety Code Section 130140 and 130105, and Sutter County Ordinance Chapter 75. Ordinance No. 1653 was adopted by the BOS on August 28, 2018 (Ord. 1572 was adopted by the BOS on June 12, 2012).

COMPENSATION: None except expenses as authorized by the Commission.

TERM OF OFFICE: Members 1 through 8 are appointed through their position per Sutter County Ordinance 1653. The 9th member shall serve for a term of three years and may serve for an unlimited number of terms.

AUTHORITY: Health and Safety Code 2200.

FORM 700: Required to be filed with the Natomas Basin Conservancy within 30-days of assuming office and then annually. Must be filed within 30-days of leaving office.

QUALIFICATIONS: The directors in every case shall be individuals who are willing to participate as members of the Directors of the Corporation. To avoid conflicts of interest, no Director shall be a current employee of the United States Fish and Wildlife Service, the United States Department of the Interior, California Department of Fish and Game or the State of California Resources Agency, at the time of serving as Director.

REQUIREMENTS: As provided for in the NBHCP, Directors must be willing to file with the corporation a verified State of California Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC) Form 700 by the first Board of Directors meeting, free of errors and omissions. The required AB1234 Ethics. Training Course provided by the FPPC is due within one year of appointment.

DUTIES: The Natomas Basin Conservancy (NBC) is the entity established for the purpose of implementing the Natomas Basin Habitat Conservation Plan on behalf of Sacramento City and Sutter County. The NBC is an independent non-profit corporation that serves as the Plan Operator under the Habitat Conservation Plan and is responsible to acquire, locate, operate, manage and maintain mitigation lands. The Board of Directors of the NBC conduct, manage and control the affairs and business of the corporation and make rules and regulations consistent with the law, the Articles of Incorporation and By-laws.

MEETINGS: Regular meetings are held the first Wednesday of February, April, June, August, October, and December.

OF VACANCIES: Currently, five vacancies exist on the Board of Directors of the Natomas Basin Conservancy. Until now, the Natomas Basin Conservancy has had five directors appointed by the City of Sacramento. Now that Sutter County has received incidental take permits from the United States Fish and Wildlife Service and from the California Department of Fish and Game, under the rules of the bylaws of the Natomas Basin Conservancy, the Sutter County Board of Supervisors may now appoint five members to the board for a total membership of ten.

TERMS OF OFFICE: Directors will be appointed in staggered terms of one, two, or three years. At the end of each of those terms, each director will then serve for a term of three years. Sutter County will appoint two members to serve one-year terms, two members to serve two-year terms, and one member to serve a three-year term.

COMPENSATION: Board Directors receive a fixed fee, as adopted by resolution of the Natomas Basin Conservancy Board, for each meeting attended (currently \$100 per meeting, maximum \$250 per month).

AUTHORITY: The Natomas Basin Habitat Conservation Plan, the associated Implementing Agreement and the Natomas Basin Conservancy By-Laws.

FORM 700: Required to be filed with the Regional Housing Authority. Must be filed within 30-days of assuming office and then annually. Must be filed within 30-days of leaving office.

REQUIREMENTS: Board of Commissioners shall consist of: 1) two persons appointed by the City of Yuba City, 2) two persons appointed by the City of Live Oak, 3) two persons appointed by the Sutter County Board of Supervisors, 4) two persons appointed by the Nevada County Board of Supervisors, and 5) one Tenant Commissioner appointed jointly by the governing boards upon recommendation of the Regional Housing Authority Board of Commissioners.

DUTIES: Commissioners establish the policies under which the organization conducts its business, seeing that the policies are being followed by the employees and ensuring that the enterprise is successful. Formal actions of the Area Housing Authority are taken through written resolutions by the Commissioners and entered in the official records of the Authority.

AUTHORITY: Pursuant to the Housing Authorities Law and more specifically the Health and Safety Code Section 34200-34402.

COMPENSATION: \$50 stipend for each meeting attended.

MEETING DATE: 1st and 3rd Wednesday each month at 12:15 p.m.

TERM OF OFFICE: Non-tenant Commissioners, four-years and Tenant Commissioner, two-years. Unscheduled vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired portion of the term. County Supervisor appointment dependent upon annual Board Committee Assignments.

APPOINTED BY: Two Commissioners appointed by each Governing Board. One Tenant Commissioner appointed jointly by all Governing Boards.
