



The **Sutter County Hall of Records** was built in 1891 of brick, concrete, granite, slate, and plaster to be as nearly fireproof as possible. Its Romanesque Revival style of simple arches, short rounded towers, and heavy masonry firmly anchoring it to the earth suggest a fortress-like security and air of permanence. It was built by the Marysville firm of Swain & Hudson and has since been restored. The building hosted the Sutter County Board of Supervisors meetings until 2019.
