Dear Sutter County CCW Holders,

I wanted to bring your attention to some changes in the CCW permit laws enacted by the California legislature and signed by the governor, effective January 1st, 2024.

I understand these changes may be frustrating, and I share your concerns. I have repeatedly expressed my opposition to the State legislature amending the law at every stage, from its infancy to its adoption. I will continue to work with the California State Sheriff's Association and will oppose any infringements on the Second Amendment.

Key Changes:

- References Required:** Applicants must now provide references as a part of the CCW permit application process.
- Mental Health Training:** New applicants and renewals must attend classes that include 1 hour of mental health training.
- Firearm Registration:** You are permitted to carry only a firearm registered to you, and joint ownership is no longer allowed for CCW's.
- Alcohol Consumption:** It is prohibited to consume alcohol while carrying or in establishments primarily for onsite consumption.
- On-Person Carry:** Your CCW permit must be carried on your person at all times.
- Appeals Process:** If denied a permit, you have the right to appeal the decision with the Sutter County Superior Court.
- Restricted Areas:** To include, but not limited to, privately owned businesses. There are specific locations where carrying is prohibited; please refer to our CCW website at SutterSheriff.org. This list is extensive, so please make yourself aware of the changes.
