CIVIC ENGAGEMENT PROCESS

Terms and Conditions

1/29/24

By participating in a civil engagement proceeding you are agreeing to be in full compliance with court-issued terms and conditions provided. Failure to complete this process once it has begun can result in penalties for immediate "DETAINMENT" of the engaging party. You are to be made aware of the terms and conditions by law and make consent with your assigned Mobile Contact Escort.

Upon choosing the Civic Engagement method for citizens to obtain Court-Appointed Vouchers you are agreeing to the terms and conditions set forth to meet requirements in successfully obtaining a voucher for a Civic Engagement Process. These vouchers are primarily for an Appearance Bond Motion set forth by a Magistrate Judge. These qualify as preset bond conditions until your next appointed court date.

AGREEING TO CIVIC ENGAGEMENT PROCESS

You will verbally state your compliance and agreement to the Civic Engagement Process to your Mobile Contact Escort.

Upon agreeing to the terms you are bound to the conditions set forth in the process. You are agreeing to comply in all directives given to stay in compliance until you have completed the Process.

OBTAINING PROPER DOCUMENTS

Below are the necessary documents to complete a Civic Engagement Process.

- Valid driver's licenses or State Id
- Proof of address with legal name
- Obtaining Electronic Bonding Voucher

PROCURING YOUR VOUCHER

Procuring your voucher is an essential element in a Civic Engagement Procedure. You are agreeing to the Civic Engagement Terms and Conditions and must produce your voucher to satisfy preset Court obligations to be used in conjunction with said documents for an Appearance Bond and Show Cause Order.

You will be instructed by a Mobile contact Escort and provided the necessary elements to undergo the designated service. You will have to make the Mobile contact Escort aware of how you will be obtaining your voucher.

This will be provided only in the form of debit and/or cash for obtaining electronic bonding vouchers for an Appearance Bond motion.

7. Citee has previously been found in contempt of a court order (specify case, court, date):

Said Defendant did miss Jury Qualification Summons after signing official documents. Actions have been taken as negligence in the Civil Proceeding and demand immediate action. Appearance Bond in conjunction with affidavit must be met to avoid detainment and required immediate response per Civic Engagement Process or surrendering of said Defendant upon arrival.



Dear Mr./Ms./Mrs.,

We are excited to announce that starting from January 1, 2023 you will now be able to make payments using our Liberty X and Coinstar Bitcoin machines. This additional payment method gives you the convenience and security of using Bitcoin for your transactions for all government officials. These kiosk units only dispense your voucher and our kiosk in the department receives them. This is the only way to securely uplift all court fees, fines, and citations for the government to record and hold all records of transactions. The purpose of this system is because sensitive information is not to be taken over the phone due to a high influx of scams because it is important to protect individuals' personal and financial details from falling into the wrong hands. Scammers often use technology and deceptive tactics to trick people into divulging sensitive information such as social security numbers, bank account details, or passwords. These scams can result in various forms of fraudulent activities, including identity theft, financial loss, and unauthorized access to personal accounts. To ensure safety and security, organizations and individuals have adopted a policy of not taking sensitive information over the phone. Instead, they typically request people to provide such details through more secure channels, such as in-person transactions, encrypted online portals, or via secure email platforms. This precautionary measure helps minimize the risk of falling victim to scams and protects individuals' sensitive data.

To utilize this service, please follow the steps below:

1. Locate the nearest Liberty X or Coinstar Bitcoin machine. You can find the nearest machine by visiting our website or by using the dedicated mobile application.
2. Once you have identified the machine, ensure that you have an official government agent assisting you through this process.
3. Go to the designated Liberty X or Coinstar machine assigned to you by your agent. Upon arrival and operation of this kiosk select the option for payment using Bitcoin/Cryptocurrency.
4. You will be prompted to scan a QR code provided by the Agent or enter a unique payment code. This information can usually be found on the payment invoice or communicated to you by the agent.
5. After scanning the QR code or entering the payment code, the machine will display the payment details, including the amount to upliftment of your citation/bond fees.

6. Once you have verified the payment details, select the "Send" or "Confirm" option on the machine's interface.
7. Upon successful completion, a confirmation message will be displayed on the machine, indicating that your payment has been processed. Please do not damage this voucher as it will be needed to be placed inside our departments kiosk.
8. **DO NOT GIVE ANYONE YOUR VERIFICATION CODE.** This code is uniquely designed for you and you alone. Only our corresponding kiosk will accept the verification code upon entering this information in our kiosk.

Please note the following important points:

- Some Liberty X and Coinstar Bitcoin machines may have a limit on the maximum transaction amount. This information will be clearly displayed on the machine. Make this information known to your agent in reference to the amount you will be uplifting.
- In case of any issues or concerns during the payment process, please contact our customer support team, who will be available to assist you. Sometimes your bank may need to be notified.
 - At this kiosk we don't accept credit cards.
- Your designated amount must be in the form of debit or cash to obtain your voucher. It must also only be on either your checking or savings in one whole amount.
- If you have a limit with your bank you should notify them to allow that transaction to be made so a hold can be avoided. Let your agent know to allow that third party call to be made.
- If you are in possession of cash a unique 10 digit docket number will be assigned to you.

We are pleased to have had to introduce our new mobile compliance management platform system. This system allows you to engage in civic participation by conveniently submitting fees, fines, and court-ordered vouchers directly to our department for the review of relevant government officials and state finances. As our local leaders continue to implement adaptive methods through digital transformations, this platform is an important step towards enhancing government services and critical legislation for the growth of our digital infrastructure, known as the C.D.B.C (Central Digital Banking Currency).

The process for submitting fines, fees, and court-ordered vouchers is straightforward. All transactions are processed through our cloud-based government technology, ensuring efficiency and security. Licensed vendors verify and add these transactions to the state's ledger, which is stored in a blockchain. This ensures transparency and accountability. The system is automatically backed up and accessible online to all relevant government officials and departments of digital finances.

We believe that this new platform will greatly simplify the process of submitting fees, fines, and court-ordered vouchers, providing you with a convenient and secure way to engage in civic participation. Follow the guidelines and instructions provided by your mobile contact Escort for a location to provide your electronic bonding voucher upon arrival, you will be provided with essential information for obtaining your voucher.

Once you have your voucher do not damage, tarnish or alter this document.

Once the voucher is obtained and fully processed out of the system you are to immediately report to the department with your driver's license or state ID, proof of address, and Electronic Bonding Voucher.

PRESENTING YOUR VOUCHER AND SIGNING YOUR AFFIDAVIT

Upon obtaining your voucher you are going to present those documents to your mobile Contact Escort

Sign a truthful AFFIDAVIT form, input your voucher into the kiosk system.

Your Civic Engagement Process will successfully be completed and a court date will be provided.
